AMENDMENT NO. 1 REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS – RFP No. 201501 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND MARKETING PLAN

Acknowledgement of this Amendment is not required. The purpose of this Amendment is to provide questions and answers to all interested Offerors.

The proposal due date and time remains February 13, 2015, at 3:00 p.m., local time.

1. ***Question: Are you looking for the consultant to host informational public meetings? If so, how many do you envision?*** ***Answer:*** The County gives latitude to Offerors to evaluate the benefit or omission of conducting public meetings in relation to supporting the stated scope of work. The Offeror's methodology should address inclusion or omission of "informational public meetings" and the respective frequency. If the Offeror determines inclusion of "information public meetings" as beneficial and necessary to meet the scope of work, the Offeror is to provide supporting language demonstrating how that particular methodology is beneficial.

If this methodology is selected, then the Offeror would conduct "informational public meetings" in collaboration with the County in designated county-arranged places or facilities.

2. ***Question: Would you like the consultant to advertise and encourage public involvement?*** ***Answer:*** The County gives latitude to Offeror's to evaluate the benefit or omission of conducting public meetings as it relates to meeting the stated scope of work. The Offeror's methodology should address inclusion or omission of "public involvement". If included as beneficial to meet the scope of work, the Offeror is to elaborate how public involvement would be beneficial. If this methodology is selected, then County resources would be available to enhance this process.
3. ***Question: Do you use shapefiles within ArcMap? If so, do you have any shapefiles or data sheets that the consultant might use for this study?*** ***Answer:*** A county affiliated agency has shapefiles within ArcMap in which access could be arranged for the successful Offeror. It is anticipated that costs for this information would be minimal.

4. ***Question: Are the optional services scheduled to happen outside the timeline and budget outlined in the initial RFP?*** Answer: Optional Services, if any, are intended to follow completion and acceptance of the Economic Development Marketing Plan. Funding of Optional Services would be separate from the budget established for RFP No. 201501.

If by virtue of this amendment you desire to change an offer already submitted, such change may be made by letter or fax, provided it includes reference to the solicitation and this amendment and is received prior to the due date and hour specified.
