County Judge John Firth called the meeting to order, led the invocation and the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.


A Public Hearing was held on the proposed Coryell County Fiscal Year 2016 Budget in accordance with local Government Code, Section 111-007 and 111-008.

5. Commissioner Jack Wall moved to drop the \$0.01 collection on the capital improvement fund. This motion died for lack of a second.


6. The court voted to approve a Fiscal Year 2016 Coryell County Budget after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second by Commissioner Don Jones. All five (5) members of the Court voted in favor of the motion.

7. Commissioner Wyllis Ament moved to adopt a 2015 tax rate of \$.458447 per \$100 in valuation. The tax rate to be broken down at \$.442587 per \$100 for the purpose of maintenance and operations and; \$.015860 per \$100 for the purpose of principal and interest on debts. The court voted approval after a second by Commissioner Jack Wall. All five (5) members of the court voted in favor of the motion.


The court adjourned this meeting after a motion by Commissioner Jack Wall and a second by Commissioner Don Jones.






JACK WALL, PRECINCT 1
