

The Coryell County Commissioners Court convened at 9:00 a.m. with a quorum present County Judge John Firth presided over the meeting.

County Judge John Firth called the meeting to order, led the invocation and the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

1. Mental Health Deputy Sgt. Fox stated the importance of what the office had accomplished. Sgt. Fox asked for more staff and two vehicles due to the large number of calls and the transportation of the people they serve. Scott Williams, Sheriff Elect for the term beginning January 1, 2017 stated that the grant funds the Mental Health program currently operates under extends through 2016. Mr. Williams stated that he feels it is a valuable program and hopes to see it extended.
2. Scott Williams spoke to the court stating the pickups currently used by the Sheriff's Department are not rated as police vehicles. Mr. Williams stated that his preference would be to use the Ford Explorer which is less expensive, has a good resell value and would serve the office better than the pickups.
3. Eric Kietzer with the Coryell County Economical presented the attached budget with a budget request of \$51,600.00. (Attached)
4. EMS of Copperas Cove and Gatesville presented a request for an increase in each of their budgets from the current \$85,000.00 to \$100,000.00. They explained that calls had increased and the un-insured people they serve leave them with unpaid bills. Both Departments expressed appreciation for all the county had done in the past.
5. Indigent Health Coordinator Lana Davidson explained the process mandated by the State of Texas to set her budget. She explained that she was very conservative with the budget while making sure that all her clients were properly treated and processed.


The court adjourned this meeting after a motion by Commissioner Jack Wall and a second by Commissioner Don Jones.
