**ADMINISTRATIVE STANDING ORDER  
ASSIGNMENT OF COURTS AND DIVISION OF CRIMINAL CASES**

---

This order is an administrative standing order of the District Courts of Coryell County that applies in all criminal cases filed with the District Clerk of Coryell County. Subject to, the Rules of Court of 52<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District of Texas Coryell County, the 52<sup>nd</sup> Judicial District Court and the 440<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court of Coryell County approve this standing order on the assignment of criminal cases. Therefore, IT IS ORDERED:

Each District Court may impanel a Grand Jury during each of the Courts' terms (January and July). Each Grand Jury shall serve a term as ordered by the empaneling Court.

All causes filed by returned Indictments by the Grand Jury will be randomly assigned and distributed among the District Courts based on the newest SID# assigned to the defendant to be determined at the time the case is submitted to the grand jury and defendants whose final number in the SID sequence of numbers is 1,2,3,4 shall be assigned to the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court and defendants whose final number in the SID sequence of numbers is 5,6,7,8,9,0 shall be assigned to the 440<sup>th</sup> District Court, subject to the following:

- (1) any subsequent cause will be assigned the same Court with a defendant's pending cause.
- (2) causes with Co-Defendants, involving the same transaction, assigned to the the to the 440<sup>th</sup> District Court.
- (3) T.D.C.J. cases assigned to the 440<sup>th</sup> District Court.

All Indictments presented to the grand jury for consideration shall include the defendant's SID number, date of birth, TRN number, complaint number, statute and citation, assigned prosecutor, retained or appointed defense attorney, and the designated Court.

All causes filed by Information shall be assigned to the 440<sup>th</sup> District Court unless the defendant has a cause pending in the 52<sup>nd</sup> District Court. All information filed shall include the defendant's SID number, date of birth, TRN number, complaint number, statute and citation, assigned prosecutor, retained or appointed defense attorney, and the designated Court.

Nothing herein will prevent judges from exchanging benches, sitting for another judge, or transferring causes between themselves, when allowed by law.

**THIS STANDING ORDER REGARDING CRIMINAL INDICTMENTS, FILINGS AND ASSIGNMENT SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ON THE 3<sup>RD</sup> DAY OF JANUARY 2017.**
