7. No Action was taken to approve a Coryell County Burn Ban.


11. Coryell County position in support of court operations regarding Section 411.209 of the Texas Government Code was discussed.

12. The court discussed the renovation of the 7th street Annex Courtroom.


The court adjourned this meeting after a motion by Commissioner Daren Moore and a second by Commissioner Don Jones.






JACK WALL, PRECINCT 1
