APPLICATION AND CONSENT TO WAIVE A JURY

NOW COMES, the undersigned defendant in the above numbered and entitled cause, and respectfully request the Court to waive the right to a trial by jury. That as a prerequisite of being tried before the Court, the Defendant presents this written Application, and states the following facts are true, to-wit:

1. That the Defendant is represented by Counsel in this cause.
2. That this Application is presented in person, and in open court, prior to the Defendant's entry of a Plea herein.
3. That this Cause is classified as a felony less than capital.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant respectfully requests the consent and approval of the Court, and Attorney representing the State, for permission to waive the right of a trial by jury, and that this Cause be tried before the Court, and if applicable, Defendant and his counsel specifically waive statutory ten days allowed for trial, and request immediate trial herein.
