The Coryell County Commissioners Court convened at 9:00 a.m. with a quorum of four members of the court attending. County Judge John Firth led the invocation, led the Pledge to the American and Texas Flags.

4. A Public Hearing was held on the second of two public hearings on the proposed Coryell County Fiscal Year 2018 Budget in accordance with local Government Code, Section 111.007 and 111.008.

5. The court discussed the proposed FY 2018 Coryell County Budget.


6. The court voted to approve a Fiscal Year 2018 Coryell County Budget after a Motion by Commissioner Don Jones and a second by Kyle Matthews.


7. The court voted that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$.5453 per \$100 in valuation, which is effectively an 11.1% increase in the tax rate. The rate shall be broken down in the following;


\$.52265 per \$100 for the purpose of maintenance and operations and:


\$.02265 per \$100 for the purpose of principal and interest on debts after a motion made by Judge John Firth and a second by Commissioner Don Jones.


The court adjourned this meeting after a motion by Commissioner Kyle Matthews and a second by Commissioner Ray Ashby.
