Minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 10, 2013

The Coryell County Historical Commission met in regular session at the Chamber of Commerce building with Chairman Homer Perryman presiding. Also present were Bob Meharg, Danny Corbett, James Powell, Nancy Ashcraft, Janelle Kerr, Hall DeBusk, and Janis Barnhill. David Scott and Letha Sheldon had excused absences.

Janelle Kerr moved to approve the minutes as read. Hall DeBusk seconded it, and the motion passed.

Nancy Ashcraft presented the Financial Report with a balance of \$12,340.18. The group voted to continue paying for membership in the National Trust for Historic Preservation.

James Powell gave the Historical Marker Report, in which the only change is that the markers for the Ruth and Pleasant Grove Cemeteries are ready for casting.

The major portion of the meeting involved making specific plans for the dedication ceremony for the Fort Hood Communities marker. Janis Barnhill reported on the publicity, the tent reservation, the speaker, and the decorations. Chairman Perryman called for a special meeting at 10:00 a.m. on September 24 at the Depot for further planning and reporting.

A group photo was made at this meeting for the County's website.

Janis Barnhill reported that she contacted the police to report vandalism at Freedom Park following the August Rodeo and to ask for future police surveillance of the park.

James Powell moved to adjourn, and Danny Corbett seconded it. The meeting was adjourned.

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 24, 2013

The Coryell County Historical Commission met in special session at 10:00 am on September 24 at the Depot with Chairman Homer Perryman presiding. Also present were Bob Meharg, Danny Corbett, Janis Barnhill, Nancy Ashcraft, David Scott, and ~~DeBusk Hall~~. *Hall DeBusk.*

The purpose of the meeting was to finalize plans for the Dedication of the Fort Hood Communities historical marker to be at 10:00 am on October 12. It was announced that the location has been changed from the military chapel to the grassy area directly across from the main gate of North Fort Hood on Highway 36.

Chairman Perryman reported that a digging permit for installing the marker is in process at South Fort Hood and with the Highway Department. There is also a requirement to install a sign stating the number of the historical marker.

The program was planned in detail. Janis Barnhill reported on the publicity, the speaker, the tent reservation, and the decorations. Chairman Perryman explained that for the roll call of each affected community, actual participants of the displacement will be asked to stand or raise their hands, and their descendants will be asked to stand. When Sylvia Edwards of the Colvin family unveils the marker, one volunteer from each named community will be asked to join her for the unveiling.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
