## ORDER PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSING OF COUNTY OFFICES

WHEREAS, the Texas State Constitution grants a County Judge broad administrative authority; and,

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has issued an Executive Order declaring January 9, 2025 as a day of mourning out of respect for James Earl Carter, Jr., the thirty-ninth President of the United States; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the County Judge of Coryell County that County Offices and Buildings will be closed to the public on January 9, 2025, to honor the memory of the late President Carter.

## IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

- 1. That citizens of Coryell County should take this opportunity to pay their respects to the late President Carter.
- 2. That nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or infringe upon the authorities granted to any other elected official in Coryell County.
- 3. That County Offices and Buildings will resume normal business hours on January 10, 2025.
